made the sixteenth day of July in the first year of the reign of our Sovereign Lady Anne by the grace of God of England Scotland France and Ireland Queen by the grace of God of her realm & dominions 1702 **Between** Edward Walrond & William Drake Esqrs Thomas Marwood and Hodges Harrant Butlers Francis Bratt Francis Bagwell alias Abbot Richard Newson Phillip Mitchell & John Reed of Knowle Yeoman & roffers in trust for the English Lands of Colston in the County of Devon of the one parte and Robert Carter of Henry & Mary in the County aforesaid woman of the other parte **Witnesseth** that they have said Edward Walrond William Drake Thomas Marwood Hodges Harrant Francis Bratt Francis Bagwell alias Abbot Richard Newson Phillip Mitchell & John Reed by & with his General Consent & appointment of Sir John Cole Bart & William Drake Kt & Bar Piddon Haydon John Lop & Eliz Bartlett Esqrs James Marwood Robert Marwood Daniel Bowdage Matthew Bartlett & Thomas Bowdage and John Blakelock & John Holwill Nicholas Fawcett Thomas Parsons Richard Lutes & Abraham Moore Yeoman & the most part of their lands being the surviving & remaining part of the worldly goods of the said wife of Colston for his heirs & his dependents elected for aid & assistance in the said trust for in consideration of the sum of Fifty & two pounds of lawful money of England unto them the aforesaid or one of them in handpay by the said Robert Carter at & before his sealing & delivery hards of the rental & payment wherof the said roffers doth hold by own & acknowledge hards of every place & part of the realm of God & every of their doth & every of their goods & chattels & every of their by their presents they the said roffers doth demise grant & to farme unto the said Robert Carter by Edward Adams & every of them by these presents **HAVE** devised granted & to farme them and by these presents they the said roffers doth demise grant & to farme unto the said Robert Carter by Edward Adams & his assigns All the land & tenement & hereditaments & every place & part of the realm of God & every of their goods & chattels & every of their by their presents lying by Sandford at Pinewill and all the land & tenement & hereditaments & every place & part of the realm of God & every of their goods & chattels & every of their by their presents lying in the parish of Totternhoe & Mary aforesaid & Calverton in the county or manor of Lord William Collyard now but now a in the possession of the said roffers their tenents & assigns together with all pallen wayes waters waterours & easements wheresover unto the said roffers & their assigns belonging or in any wise appertaining thereto & always reserved out of the present devise & grant unto the said roffers their lands & tenements & hereditaments All the timber trees & young trees likely to prove timber trees now growing and being or which heretofore in & upon the said devised premises shall grow & be with free liberty to take & carry away the same trees as aforesaid & regresse att all times during the termes hereby granted for the rearing & surveying of the same premises **To have and to hold** all & singular the said roffers & place of land & premises wth their & every of their appurtenances (except before excepted) unto the said Robert Carter by Edward Adams & assignes for & during the full time & term of four years & quindecim years from thenceforth next ensuing & fully to be compayned repaid & paid by him to the said Robert Carter Mary Carter his now wife & Richard Mountstevens the younger of Totternhoe & Mary after any or deth of them shall so long happen to live yeilding & paying therefore yearly during the said termes unto the said roffers their rents & assignes the sum or rent of four pound stellings & one pence of lawful English money on the feasts of St Michael the archangel the birth of God the annunciation of the blessed virgin & St John Baptist by divers & equal portions And also yeilding & paying unto the said roffers their rents & assignes immediately upon & after the severall deaths of the said Robert Carter Mary Carter his wife & the said Richard Mountstevens the younger they dying successively and after the other the sum of four pound stellings & one pence of lawful English money for & in the name of an hundred or there biue **And** the said Robert Carter for himself his Edwards Adams & assignes for every of them doth commandemt & graunt to & with the said roffers their rents & assignes & every of them by these presents that he the said Robert Carter by Edward Adams & assignes & every of them shall & will from hence to hence & at all times hereafter at his & their own roffers & charges wth suffitiently repair & maintain the said roffers & premises in doing & founding & in all other wch full & necessary reparations whereto whereto as often as wch shall require during the said termes in all things wch & suffitiently repaired & made in the end of the said termes shall & will leave & yield up unto the said roffers or the survivor of them their rents & assignes And if it shall happen the said yearly rent of four pound stellings & one pence to be behind & unpaid in part or in all by the space of fifteene days next after any of the said feasts or rents of payment wherof the same ought to be paid being lawfully demanded such payd & wch sufficient dishes in or upon the premises or some place whereof in the meand time can or may be had for the laying of the same rent or debt behind with the arraignment thereof if any happen to be OR if the said Robert Carter by Edward Adams & assignes or any of them shall willingly doe or suffer to be done any act or acts thing or things wheresover which shall or may be prejudiciall to the estate of inheritance of the said roffers their rents & assignes of his said devised premises OR if the said Robert Carter by Edward Adams or any of them shall doe or comitt or willingly suffer to be done or committed any manner of voluntary waste in upon the premises or any part therof at any time during the said termes to the value of twenty stellings or more & shall not suffitiently repair the same with three monthes next after notice to be given by the said roffers their rents & assignes or by their bay biff or Bay biffs for his hars being that same from thenceforth for all any or deth of the said premises and therof may be lawfull to be for the said roffers their rents & assignes & every of them into the said premises or any part therof to render & the said Edward Adams & John Reed to have again & retain as in thair former estate their rents or any thing therin contained to the contrary notwithstanding **And** the said Edward Walrond William Drake Thomas Marwood Hodges Harrant Francis Bratt Francis Bagwell alias Abbot Richard Newson Phillip Mitchell & John Reed do for themselves severally & apart & rate one of them for himself & for his own hars Edward Adams & John Reed only & not jointly commandemt & graunt to & with the said Robert Carter by Edward Adams & assignes & to & with every of them by these presents that he the said Robert Carter by Edward Adams & assignes & every of them by Edward Adams & assignes & agreements aforesaid shall & lawfully may reasonably & quickly have hold possess & enjoy all & singular the said devised premises & every place & part therof with their & every of their appurtenances (except before excepted) during the termes & estate hereby granted without any lawfull hindrance molestation diversion or damage of for by the said roffers their rents & assignes or any or deth of them or any other person or persons wheresover lawfully claiming or which may for claim the same premises by force or wch the same any or deth of them respectively **And** heat to the said Robert Carter shall at any time within the space of two years next coming after the date of these presents on his desir & request have the roddons & privyledge to decharge the life of the said Richard Mountstevens and in his room & place to put any other person life provided heat to the said Richard Mountstevens be at his hars of such request in sound & perfect bodily health And also provided that the said Robert Carter do & have surrendred & yield up his present inheritance of his & at his charge provide to be made & buried unto the said roffers their rents & assignes a new lease of the premises for that purpose containing like rents & services & burdens wch the said presents shall claime for discharge of the last life only desired In witness whereof the aforesaid have signed their
