

Will & Testament made the Twenty fourth day of June in the third year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord George by the Grace of God of Great Britain France and Ireland King Defender  
 of the Faith Anno Domini 1718 Between William Drake Esq Thomas Marwood gent Francis Bratt Phillip Mitchell and John Reed Esq Gentlemen and John Head of Kewell Feoffee in Trust of the parish Church of Colton in the  
 County of Devon of the one part and Margaret Bastyan late wife of George Bastyan of Ottery St Mary in the County aforesaid of the other part **Witnesseth** That they the said William  
 Drake Thomas Marwood Francis Bratt Phillip Mitchell and John Reed by and with the general Consent and Consent of the Twenty men of the parish of Colton aforesaid for and in Consideration of a Surrender of a part  
 of the present Estate of his said Margaret Bastyan contained in the premises hereafter in these presents mentioned to be demised and of all yearly Rent Servants Conduits and other Accidents heretofore in and by these presents reserved  
 and Mentioned **Leave** To my Leased and to have Let to them and by these presents they the said Feoffee Doe Denise Leafe and to have Let unto them and Margaret Bastyan her Executors Administrators and Assignees **2000**  
 Pounds Sterling or Dwellinghouse and one acre of land converted into three Tenements or Dwelling houses and the court yard Backside and Her garden to the same belonging situated lying and Being in Mill street in the Town of  
 Ottery St Mary aforesaid heretofore in the possession of George Bastyan deceased but now in the possession of the said Margaret Bastyan her assigns Uncertaint or Uncertainants Except and always reserved out of this  
 to her Demise unto the said Feoffee their Heires and Assignees All Timber Trees and other Goods now growing or to grow in and upon the premises with free liberty to have and take the same during his term hereby granted  
**To have and to hold** All and Singular the said Premises with the appurtenances (Except before Excepted) unto the said Margaret Bastyan her Executors Administrators and Assignees from the day of this Date hereof  
 for and during the full time and terms of four score and Nineteen years from the date ensuing and fully to be complete Excepted and ended If Walter Bastyan and Diana Bastyan his Daughter and Walter Bastyan Junr Son of Walter  
 Bastyan brother of the said George Bastyan above mentioned or any or either of them shall happen so long to live **Yielding** and paying therefor yearly and every year during the term unto the said Feoffee their Heires and  
 Assignees the sum of Eleaven Shillings of gold and lawful money of Great Britaine at the sum most usual Geats or Terms in the year (That is to say) at his Geats of Execution his Arrenging the Birth of our Lord God the  
 Annunciation of the blessed Virgin in Chery and St John the Baptist by Etan and Equal portions **And** also yielding and paying unto the said Feoffee their Heires and Assignees upon the several deaths of him the said Walter Bastyan and  
 Diana Bastyan and Walter Bastyan Junr and upon the death of every of them And likewise yielding and paying unto the said Feoffee their Heires and Assignees upon the death of every other person or persons who shall happen to die Tenant  
 or Tenant in the possession of the sum of Eleaven Shillings Lawfull money of Great Britaine for and in the name of an Heire or Heires **And** the said Margaret Bastyan shall for her self her Executors Administrators and  
 Assignees Covenant Promise Grant and agree to and with the said Feoffee their Heires and Assignees and to and with every of them by these presents in manner and form following (That is to say) That she the said Margaret Bastyan  
 her Executors Administrators and Assignees shall and will at her and their own proper costs and charges well and sufficiently Repair Maintain uphold and Amend all and Singular the said Demised Dwelling house and premises  
 with the appurtenances during the said Term as well in Walling Timbering and Covering as in all other needfull and necessary Repairements whatsoeuer when and as often as need shall require And the same premises and every part and  
 parcel thereof to be well and sufficiently in all things Repaired and minded in the end of the said Term shall and will peaceably and quietly leave and yield up unto the said Feoffee their Heires and Assignees And if the said yearly  
 Rent of Eleaven Shillings or any part thereof shall be behind and unpaid in part or in all by the space of Fifteen days next after any of the said Geats or Days of payment wherein the same ought to be paid being lawfully demand and  
 then not paid and no sufficient distress in and upon the said premises can or may be found to satisfy the same with the arreages thereof if any happen to be **Or** if the said Margaret Bastyan her Executors Administrators or  
 Assignees shall do any act matter or thing that may be judicial for the Estate of inheritance of the said Feoffee their Heires or Assignees **Or** shall suffer the same to be ruined and in decay to the  
 value of Seven Shillings or above and shall not Repair and Amend the same within Six months after to come or from thence given by the said Feoffee their Heires or Assignees or their Bayliff or Bayliffs for the same being But  
 if the decay or ruin thereof shall happen to be by misfortune or accident of fire then to have **One year** next after for the new building and Repairing thereof That then it shall and may be lawfull for the said Feoffee their Heires and  
 Assignees for all any or either of his feoffees aforesaid into the said Demised premises to Reenter and have and enjoy all and every part and parcel therof to have against trespasses and annoy as it was and had former estate any thing therein  
 contained to the contrary notwithstanding **And** the said William Drake Thomas Marwood Francis Bratt Phillip Mitchell and John Reed each one of them for himself and for his own Heires **And** his  
 Heires only and not jointly his Tenant and grantee and with the said Margaret Bastyan her Executors Administrators and Assignees by these presents that she the said Margaret Bastyan her Executors Administrators and  
 Assignees and every of them shall and lawfully may peaceably and quietly have hold and enjoy all and singular the said Demised premises with his appurtenances from henceforth during the said Term of Ninety nine years  
 Datable namely as aforesaid by and under the Rents heretofore Excepted tenants and other Accidents aforesaid without any Manner of Lawfull Let Suit Preble Interrogation or Denial of the said Feoffee their Heires  
 or Assignees or any or either of them respectively **In witness whereof** the parties to these presents their hands and seals intermanently have set yea on this day and year first above written
