

This Indenture made the viijth day of the Month of Iunyth. John the baptiste he had a sonnes yere of the raigne of our Raigne lord and Ladie Philippa marie by the grace of god kyng and Q^{ue}ene of Englynde Spayne armes of both Cnrtre Jerusalem and of Ireland defendred of the partth Ansgard Duke of Burgundaynaland Brabant. Dukes of Gascoigne of Almaine and of breck. **Wittenesysnge** hat wthered John Strobridge of Colston in the Comte of Denon gentilman Williath Strobridge of stene Payne maner from the foreside Comte of Denon gentilman John Morris of Colston forefaire in the foreside Comte of Denon gentilman John hame of Colston forefaire gentilman and he saide of stene Payne maner from within the fesse of stene Payne maner forefaire. know you hem he said John Strobridge Williath Strobridge John Morris and John hame for divers qdth considerations hym montynge and specially for that the lessys in his indenture have taken apone hym the repon of a mesnage and claes of grounde to the same advereyng herwthyn to hym demyde beyng at his sent in frenche to have demyde granted and to ferme lette unto synguler stane and dñe his wiffe of stene Payne maner forefaire one mesnage a Cestelinge and a garden to the same advereyng with happeninge of the tenme of oide stane seth lyng and beynge in the towne of stene Payne maner forefaire in the north west parte of the kyng and Q^{ue}nes way betwyne the land of Williath Sano or the Soncheste and the londe of the land of mande hame decessde of the iste And also one chace of lande to the same mesnage belonginge of the same tenme lyng at Capphill in stene Payne maner forefaire contynunge by estimation two dyres of grounde. And on other chace of grounde to the same belonginge of the same tenme lyng at Cuerdale contynunge two dyres of grounde. And one other chace of the same tenme to the same advereyng lyng at kyngston park contynunge by estimation one dyre of londe. Whys all a singuler of latte were in the tenme of one Williath Strobridge decessde. **To haue and to hold** all he forefaire mesnage Cestelinge garden and the chaces of grounde forefaire with happeninge to he forefaire synguler stane and dñe his wiffe and to her assygned from the daye of the date herof untill heire and tenme of thame stane and latte yere hem mett and immidiatly esynge synguler and plenari to be compleide and endide is hym the same synguler stane and dñe his wiffe hym selfe or one of hym selfe longe. **Yeldeynge & payente** before yecche to do he said John Williath John and John hame to owe hem and assygned twenty shillings of god and lawfull mony of Englynde at thame purissall tyme of the yere that is to saye at the feaste of Payne myself transyng he biff of a lord god hadmuntion of our ladye the ladie of dyngne and he blantinc of Payne John the baptiste by even portion to be paid. And the same synguler and dñe land hefster of hym longe lyng and her assygned the same mesnage Cestelinge garden and chace of grounde with happeninge in all hows heffed and dñed whan and as often as nedth shall repaire vphold sustayne and marytayne to her owene rett and marge bryngynge the forefaire tenme is the same synguler and dñe selfe longe lyng or one of hym selfe longe to hym. **And** shall alse kepe and paye vpon he death of any of the synguler and dñe selfe shillinge in mony in the name of an herote **PROVIDED** alwayes that vpon he death of the said dñe selfe longe to hym the said his husband no heire shall haue required to warde he repon of all he comfis to with happeninge the said synguler and dñe selfe and her assygned and any of hym longe lyng shall haue great tumber of any heires gowynge report and ple of he comfis by dyngne. And also staled ffor th flurke & cattale of he comfis and shredynge of ffre and of he vnderland her tyngene or herfster to grove withoute decessde or deuayng. **And if** his happen he said heire is twentie shillings or any pte of he comfis to be lebynd and payde by he spate of one moneth made after am feaste of the forefaire feasted in wham hame shal oute to be paide if hit be lawfullly demandyd be any pte of he said synguler and dñe selfe and her assygned he comfis and any pte of he comfis with happeninge whan and as often as nedth shall requir do not suffisally vphold repaire marytayne he comfis butt dosyppe the same to be in ryne by he spate of one halfe yere after he shalbe comfised to Almed the same by to he said John Williath John and John hame or by one of hym selfe he comfis and into any che and pte of he comfis with happeninge to recet and he same to haue rayne and rayne as in her ffeaste astafe had grante or any heire contyned to he contary shreder or yeldynge vpp of the said synguler stane and dñe selfe his wiffe all and singuler he forefaire mesnage Cestelinge garden and chace of grounde with happeninge shall come and haue remayne to hame one of the daughter of the said synguler and dñe selfe and to her assygned for and bryngynge he hole tyme of thame stane and tenme yeres he comfis and immidiatly esynge after he death shreder or yeldynge vpp of he said synguler and dñe selfe and dñe selfe and plenari to be compleide and endide is he same pte longe. **Yeldeynge and payente** **3 dyngne** before yecche to hym the forefaire John Williath John and John hame to her heire and assygned all and all man of his tenme synguler and herfster ab he said synguler and dñe selfe by heire synguler bounde to yelde paye and to do. **And they** the forefaire John Williath John and John hame her heire and assygned all and singuler he comfis with happeninge in maner and forme alone side to he forefaire synguler dñe selfe and hame and to the longste lyng of hym and to her assygned alwey agaynst he heire lord or lord of herfster offred hym agaynst all other people for heire. A forefaire shall warante dynge and defende by his selfe dynge he forefaire, if he said synguler dñe selfe and John hame longe or one of hym longe to come. In witness wroth let this loneknde to heire Indentured her seall & seal entreamteable hame left he daye and yere firste Almoncifer.
