

His indenture made the fourteenth daie of September in the year of the reign of our most gracious Sovereign Lord Edward the first King of England & France & of Scotland the one and thirtieth year of his said Majesty's reign in the County of Somerset between **Mirgosa** Gallows of Causton in the County of Somerset and John de la Haye of Causton in the County of Devon

that whereas the said John de la Haye hath by his indenture bearing date the twentieth daie of June in the second year of the said King's reign assigned unto the said Mirgosa Gallows the tenements and messuages and appurtenances thereto in the County of Devon and the tenements and messuages and appurtenances thereto in the County of Somerset

So haue the said Mirgosa Gallows and the said John de la Haye agreed that the said John de la Haye shall and lawfully do give and pay unto the said Mirgosa Gallows the sum of twenty pounds of lawful money of England to him in hand paid by the said John de la Haye at the feast of Michaelmas next following the date of the date of the said indenture

So haue the said Mirgosa Gallows and the said John de la Haye agreed that the said John de la Haye shall and lawfully do give and pay unto the said Mirgosa Gallows the sum of ten pounds of lawful money of England to him in hand paid by the said John de la Haye at the feast of Michaelmas next following the date of the date of the said indenture
