goods & chattels of George Barber late of Woother in the ffeoffement County of Dorset deceased daughter of the said George of the other ffeoffement Witneseth that the said Edmond Walrond jun William said George Barber the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged as alſo for and in Consideration of the yearly rent heretofore paid by the said ffoffees or their Assignes hanc demised bage granted to farms let by the said ffoffees or their Assignes hanc demised bage granted to farms let by the said ffoffees or their Assignes to farme lett unto the said Elizabeth Webber all that messuage & tenement at Laynton in the fyfth of Shute in the County of Devon aforesaid commonly called or knowne by the name of Newe Combe two Closes & fields of Land & pasture commonly called by the name or names of the divers Closes & tenements by estimation three acres be they more or less and severall other Closes & fields of Land & pasture together in all houses out houses gardens & orchards to the said messuage and tenement belonging or in any way appertaining all which ffeoffement now are in the use or occupancy of the said Elizabeth Webber her Assignes or Assignes except and always reserved out of this ffeoffement unto the said ffoffees their Lode & Assignes all the trees now growing or being or which hereafter shall growe or be in or upon the premises or any part thereof with free liberty to & for the said ffoffees their Bayleiff or Bayleiffs Servant or Servants to have sell and away the same at hire & charege during the termes only excepted for p[er]petuity to haue & to hold all the said messuage & tenement Closes & fields of land & pasture in theire dudy of theire appertinances (except before excepted) unto the said Elizabeth Webber her Assignes immediately from and after the day of the date hereof for & during the full time & terme of fourty & myghte years from thence next ensuinge & fully to be compleat & expired ended, If the said Elizabeth Webber shall so longe happen to live yeildinge & payinge her yearly & due years during the said Edmond Walrond jun William Drake Thomas Sampson & Thomas Marwood Francis Pratt Francis Bagwell jun Hodges ffarrant Allen Abbott Richard Newton jun John ffreaks Phillip Mitchell jun & John Reeds ffoffees aforesaid to their Lode & Assignes the sum or yearly Rent of five pounds & four shillings of lawfull mony of England the first day of November and on the third day of May by even & equal portions and likewise yeildinge & payinge imediately vpon & after the death of the said Elizabeth Webber unto the said ffoffees their Lode & Assignes the sum of four shillings & sixpence in the name of a Heriot and likewise yeildinge & payinge dore & performinge suete & service to all the Courts of Survey of the said ffoffees their Lode & Assignes as shall be hidden in the fyfth of Colyton aforesaid as other theire benefits of their fyfth Lands have done & ought to doe upon reasonable warninge to the said Elizabeth Webber or her Assignes given and the said Elizabeth Webber for her selfe & her Assignes deſire & grant to & to the said Edmond Walrond jun William Drake Thomas Sampson & Thomas Marwood Francis Pratt Francis Bagwell jun Hodges ffarrant Allen Abbott Richard Newton jun John ffreaks Phillip Mitchell jun & John Reeds their Lode & Assignes to and the dudy of them by the said ffoffees that she the said Elizabeth Webber & her Assignes shall & will at her & their owne proper cost & charge well & sufficiently reparis & maintaine all singular the said Demised ffeoffement & fyfth thereof as well in walling timbering & stoninge in dyringe heddinge & fentringe & all manner of other needfull & necessary reparations whatsoevre thereon as needed shall require during the said termes & in the end thereof the same ffeoffement & so well & sufficiently repaired shall & will leave & yield up into the stande & possession of the said ffoffees their Lode & Assignes. But if it shall hapen that the said yearly Rent of five pounds & four shillings shall be botinde unpaid in parte or in all by the space of one & twenty dayes next after any of the said dayes of payment in whiche aforesaid it ought to be paid the same being lawfully demanded & then not paid & no sufficient distres in or upon the premises can or may be found for the levyinge of the said Rent soe beinge behinde the same therof if any shall happen to be OR if the said Elizabeth Webber or her Assignes shall willingly doe by her or their assent or prudencie or suffer to be done any act or acts thing or things whatsoever whiche shal or may tend or be to the prejudicement or diminution of the said ffoffees their Lode & Assignes of the said ffeoffement & fyfth that then for evy or any of the causes aforesaid this present lease & grant & the terme hereby limited shall to afofeoffement be void, & then & from thence forth for all or any of the said causes it shall & may be lawfull to & for the said ffoffees their Lode & Assignes into a & singular the said Demised ffeoffement & fyfth appertinent to render & the same to have againe & enjoye as in their ffeoffement former Estates these Indentures or any thinge in them contained to the contrary therof in any wise notwithstandinge and the said Edmond Walrond jun William Drake Thomas Sampson & Thomas Marwood Francis Pratt Francis Bagwell jun Hodges ffarrant Allen Abbott Richard Newton jun John ffreaks Phillip Mitchell jun & John Reeds ffoffees aforesaid & their Lode & Assignes by these presents Demised & fyfth thereof to thayre p[er]petuities (except before excepted) unto the said Elizabeth Webber her Assignes in manner & forms aforesaid & under the Rents & Conduces & agreements before expressed & reserved against all persons shall & will warrant acquitt & defend by these presents during the said termes in whiche the parties aboue named have to the said ffeoffement interchangingably their hands & Seales sett this daye before first above written Anno Domini 1687.
