the said aforesaid Indenture of Leas for the Consideration therin mentioned affignt and Convey unto the said Abraham Barber his Executors Administrators and assignes all and singular the herein before mentioned and aforesaid promised with the Appurtenances And all her Right Estates Cycles and
Interest therein and thereunto belonging and by the said aforesaid Indenture of Leas and writing or Instrument in writing Indorsed on the back thereof doth and may more fully and at large saye and **WITNESSE** now these presents that the said Abraham Barber for and in Consideration of the
summe of Sixty and five pounds + x + of good and lawfull money of England to him in hand payed by the said James Gould = x = x = x = x = attend before the Sealing and Delivery hereof he the said Abraham Barber doth hereby acknowledge and thereof and of every parte and partall theron for
Aquit Release and discharge the said James Gould = x = x = his Executors Administrators and assignes and every of them by these presents **HATH** granted bargained sold affigned and set over and by these presents **DOETH** grant bargain sell affigne and set over unto the said James Gould = x = x = x = his
Executors Administrators and assignes = x = **ALL** that he herein before aforesaid Messuage and Tenement Esq and parts of Land and pasture and all and Singular other the herein before mentioned and aforesaid promised with the Appurtenances And all the Estates Right Cycles Interest Estate and Termes of datus therein yet to
come and unexpired property belonging and demand whatsoever both in Law or Equity or otherwise howsover of the said Abraham Barber of into and out of the said premises and every or any part or partall theron with the Appurtenances Yelding Paying Renting Deding and Obeying for the said premises all such
Rents Annuall Atturments Fines and Penalties and agreements whatsoever in the said aforesaid Indenture of Leas mentioned doth and ought to be yelde paid borne observed for the same **AND** the said Abraham Barber for himself his Executors Administrators Doth Covenant promise and
grant to and with the said James Gould = x = x = x = his Executors and assignes by these presents in himselfe good right full power and lawfull Authority to grant and affigne the said premises with the x = x
Appurtenances unto the said James Gould = x = x = x = his Executors Administrators and assignes in manner and forme aforesaid **AND** that the said James Gould = x = x = x = his Executors Administrators and assignes shall and may quietly and peaceably have hold occupye posesse and enjoy all the said premises with the Appurtenances
and Indenture to the true intent and meaning of these presents without the lawfull lett or sue or to the best hinderance or interruption paying or demanding whatsoever lawfully layning or to layne by from or
under him or any of them **AND** that the said James Gould = x = x = x = his Executors Administrators and assignes shall and may quietlie and peaceably arquited exonerated and discharged of and from all former and other his said Bargaines also assignments debts and Injuries made done suffered or committed by the said Abraham
Barber or any other person or persons whatsoever lawfully layning or to layne the said premises or any parte or partall theron by from or under him **AND** that he the said Abraham Barber his Executors Administrators and all and every other person or persons lawfully layning or to layne the
said premises or any parte or partall theron by from or under him or any of them shall and will from time to time and at all times hereafter during the continuall of the said aforesaid termes upon the reasonable request And at the costs and charges in the law of the said James Gould = x = x = x =
his Executors and assignes make do and execute or cause and procure to be made done and executed all and every such further and other lawfull and reasonable Actions chiting and things devised by him and conveyanted in the law whatsoever for the further and better effording kelyfying and re-
refixing of these presents and the Grant and assignment hereby made or intended to be made according to the true intent and meaning hereof as by the said James Gould = x = x = x = his Executors Administrators and assignes or his on their counseil learned in the Law shall be reasonably devised
