The condition of this obligation is such that if the

 their heirs executori et admittenti or assigns or any
 or either of them do and shall well and truly
 pay or cause to be paid unto the above named William
 Drake, Thomas Sampson and John Abbott their
 executori et admittenti or assigns or to some or one of
 them the full sum of forty shillings of
 lawful money of England (all or in the Chamber
 called the Exchequer for the use of the Officers
 of the parish of Colyton aforesaid) in manner and form
 followinge (that is to say) Ten shillings thereof
 all or upon the first day of November next
 ensuinge the date hereof at the place aforesaid
 Ten shillings more thereof all or upon the
 first day of November next shall be in the year of our
 Lord God one thousand six hundred seventie and
 eight at the place aforesaid And soe forward on
 every year on the said first day of November the
 said sume of Ten shillings untill the said sume
 of forty shillings shall be in such manner fully
 satisfied and paid That then this obligation to be
 voyed But if default of paym^t shall happen to be
 in all any or either of the said paym^ts contrary to
 the forme aforesaid that then this obligation to
 remaine in full power & vertue.
