# A Contract Between The Chamber of Colyton and Hugh Wood. The Conditions as Followeth.

That we the Feoffees and Twenty men together with Hugh Wood do hereby Acknowledge to have lett and taken by us the said Hugh Wood the Markets and Fairs of Colyton aforesaid for the Term of Fourteen years from Lady Day next for the sum of Twenty five pounds p<sup>a</sup> annum by Quarterly Payments, & the Feoffees do further agree with the said Hugh Wood that we will Repair Maintain and Keep in good Tennantable Repair, all the Chambers Markitt place Suburbs and to Endow Vicar and School and all other necessary Utensils made use of Relating to the said Fair and Markitt And it is further agreed that the said Feoffees and Twenty men Doth promise and agree to Indemnify the said Hugh Wood in any Inditements which may be Lawfully against any Marchers or Fore stallers who shall Infringe upon the said Markets Property of the said Markitt and Fair of Colyton aforesaid Given under our Hands this eighteenth Day of March 1750
