London June 25<sup>th</sup> 1766

I have perused y<sup>e</sup> Copy of the Contract entered into betw<sup>en</sup> the Chamber of Colyton & Hugh Beed relating to the Fair & Markets of Colyton, and I think that Beed has bound himself thereby to the paymt. of 25 a year for a Rent for the same for 14 years from y<sup>e</sup> Ladyday next after the date of the Contract, and that Beed's giving the Key to an<sup>y</sup> person & refusing to hold y<sup>e</sup> p<sup>l</sup>ms after three or four years enjoyment thereof, will not discharge him from his Contract, and I think that the proper way of proceeding ag<sup>t</sup> him, is by Action of Debt for the whole Rent and this Contract ~~will~~ may be given in Evidence. But then it must be stamped, which will cost a good deal of money, and if I mistake not you informed me that Beed was very poor, so that the Chamber had best consider w<sup>h</sup> it is worth their while to put themselves to the Expence of having this Contract stamped & bringing an Action ag<sup>t</sup> an Insolvent Debt<sup>r</sup>. I will let you have the Contract at the Sessions. I am
