Item I doe give & bequeath unto y^e poore of y^e gish of Colyton
five pounds & that it shall forever remaine to y^e aforesaid gish
for y^e aforesaid poore to these uses & to no other; That is to say,
that three poore artificers or handye Craftes men shall have y^e
use & occupation thereof for one whole yeere upon good bond wth
sureties given to y^e said gish for y^e repaym^t. thereof at y^e yeeres
end, & then y^e next yeere to three other, & soe to three every yeere
for ever. Or else y^t y^e said five poundes may be put out to use for
y^e saide poore, & y^t y^e use thereof yearly at Christmas may be bestow-
ed vppon two poore people one yeare & y^e next yeare to two others
& soe to continue to two forever to buy them some apparrell.
