It is supposed that the greatest part of the others, if not all of them, will also compound on the above terms.

The only Poor Rate Mr. Barnes has is one made in the year 1791, which is sent herewith, but the names are so much altered, it is of very little use, and Mr. Law had better procure a more recent Rate.

The whole Rate of the Parish is £17¹¹ 14¹¹ 10¹¹ - of which the Great Tythes are rated 9⁰/₈ and the vicarage 7¹/₈ being lately raised from 2¹/₈ to that sum - There are 64 Rates in the year.
