Robert Cillon one of the eschequer clerks of the  
parish of Eulliton on his oath doth present that  
a certain common horseway within the parish  
of Braunton in this County and leading  
from the Town of Eulliton in this County to  
the City of Exon at a certain place within  
the said parish of Braunton (as he supposed)  
commonly called Laddish Lane the first of October  
instant was and yet is foundered ruinous and  
in decay for want of repairation & amendment  
of the same way soe as the Kinges Rides peopel  
cannot travell that way with horses carts and  
charriages as they ought and were wont to doe  
without evident danger And farther saye that  
the supposed parishioners & inhabitants  
of Braunton aforesaid ought to repair the  
same way as appoynted as needfull.
