Colyton in the County of Devon Chamber one of the Surviving feoffees  
of the lands belonging to the parish of Colyton aforesaid greeting  
know ye mee the said John Keede for divers good causes & considerations  
mee hereunto moving Do here give, granted, remised, released and  
quite claimed. And by these presents doe for mee & my heirs remise, release  
& quite claime unto Walter yonge Esq<sup>r</sup> one other of the feoffees of the  
lands belonging to the parish of Colyton aforesaid his heirs and  
assignes for ever All my Estate, right, title, blame, terme, interest  
& demand whatsoever of me & to all & singler the messuages, landes, tenem<sup>ts</sup>,  
meadowes, leasdes, pastures, feedings, rents, revenues, profits, commodities  
& hereditaments whatsoever with their & others of their appointed  
belonging unto the parish or parishes of Colyton aforesaid, and with  
were granted & misseoffred in trust to the said Walter yonge mee  
the said John Keede & others. Do have & to hold all & singler  
the said messuages, landes, tenem<sup>ts</sup>, and all other the before mentioned  
promised and every part & partell thereof with the appointed, and all my  
Estate, right, title, blame & demand whatsoever of me & to the same and  
of me & to every pt & part thereof unto the said Walter yonge his heirs  
& assignes for ever. To the intent & purpose that he the said Walter  
yonge shall grant, convey, & misseoffre all & singler the same landes &  
promised here by released with the appointed unto such & so many  
persons as to him the said Walter yonge shall seeme fitt & convenient  
for the only benefitt & behoofe of the parish & parishes of  
Colyton aforesaid. In witness whereof the said John Keede  
to these presents my hand & scale have sett given the xxvij<sup>th</sup> day of
