Where the Appoynted and Incomptible persons named and described
in the said Indenture do give as condition that the said John Wood shall have
out of the said stocks the sum of twenty pounds yearly
and therein by him given for the redempcion of the said
said stocks unto the said John Wood named above and at
such rate required of him or his executor or administrators,
and residue to be returned in his hands and by him to
be employed for the bettering or works of the said
in Colyton and shall not be able to recover any
works from him to him, nor to the said John Wood
himself and his heirs to demand which are and shall
not be paid of the said John Wood.

The rendition of this obligation is such, that whereas the above bounden John Herod hath
 recaved into his hands of the parish money of Colton aforesaid the sume of Twentie
 poundes of good & lawfull money of England to remayne in his hands and by him to be
 employed for the setting on worke of such people in Colton wh[ic]h said parish of Colton as
 shall not be able to procure themselves worke from tyme to tyme; yf here fore the said
 John Herod & Peter Turkin or one of them or one of their exorutors or administrators
 shall & doe w[ith]in the space of thre monethes next after warninge to hem or one of them in this
 behalfe to be given by the above named Walter Yonge & John Burnard or either of them, hem
 or either of their exorutors or assignes, w[ith] a true asw[er]e & paye in our cause to be truly
 paid in unto the said Walter Yonge & John Burnard or one of them their or one of their exorutors
 or assignes the said sume of Twentie poundes of good & lawfull money of England Then this
 obligation to be void, Or els to be in force.
