 respective heirs Executors or administrators of the others to covenant promise and agree to and with the said Thomas Dearwood and Philip Mitchell their heirs Executors and administrators by these presents
 in manner and form following (that is to say) that they the said John Sampson William Dampfist Thomas Drake Mis Voryard Francis Beatt Thomas Spode ^{the other} Benedictus Mauwood William Walsend William Hampfist ^{the other} Thomas Dossbins John
 Bayloix and Edward Squire any or either of them or their or either of their heirs shall not nor will at any time hereafter sell lett give grant or demise the aforesaid promises or any of them or any part
 or part thereof to any person or persons whatsoever otherwise than shall be from time to time directed and appointed by the said Heoffes and twenty men of the parish of Colyton aforesaid or the
 more part of them for the time being and further when and at such time as the said John Sampson William Dampfist Thomas Drake Mis Voryard Francis Beatt Thomas Spode ^{the other} Benedictus Mauwood William Walsend William Hampfist ^{the other}
 Thomas Dossbins John Bayloix and Edward Squire shall by death or otherwise be reduced to the number three then such three surviving Heoffes shall upon reasonable request to them to be made in that
