



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GIRL TAKEN AWAY FROM SCHOOL

ARTHUR ALBERT BROOKS, an omnibus driver, of Berrenger Road, Muswell Hill, N., who took his daughter away from Tollington High School, to which she had obtained a scholarship when she was 14, was ordered by MR. REGISTRAR FRIEND at Clerkenwell County Court yesterday to pay a penalty of £5 to the Middlesex County Council, for a breach of the scholarship agreement to allow her to stay till she was 16. Brooks contended that he was not liable since a clause in the agreement required a parent to notify the governors of any change in his circumstances. He asked for an interview, but was refused. MR. REGISTRAR FRIEND said the reference was to an appreciation and not to a depreciation of the parents' circumstances. There was nothing in the agreement suggesting compulsion on the governors to grant any interview. At the close of the case the Registrar expressed dissatisfaction with the Middlesex County Council for not being represented by counsel or solicitor.
