Nathaniel Ayon Still

This is the last will and Testament of me Nathaniel Tryon Still of Administer in the County of Devon <sup>to bequeath</sup> - I give devise and bequeath all my property both real and personal and of what nature or kind soever and wheresoever situated whereof or whereto I or any person or persons in trust for me am is or are seized or entitled to or which I have power to give or dispose of by this my will unto my Son John Thomas Still his heirs executors administrators and assigns absolutely subject nevertheless as hereinafter is expressed - I give unto my dear Wife Mary Still an annuity of three hundred pounds during her natural life charged and chargeable upon all my real estates with powers of Distress and entry for the recovery thereof if in arrear at any time for fourteen days and the attendant and incidental costs and charges as if the same had been secured by a Lease for years And I direct the said annual sum to be paid by equal half yearly payments with a proportionate part up to the day of the decease of my said Wife and the first payment to be made six calendar Months after my decease - I give and devise all real estate vested in me as trustee or mortgagee unto the said John Thomas Still subject to the equities affecting the same respectively And I appoint the said John Thomas Still executor of this my will And lastly making all former wills I declare this to be my last will and Testament.
