

**This Indenture** Made the twentieth day of July, in the year of the raigne of our most gracious souveraine lord James by the grace of God of England ffraunce & Irelond  
Emperour of the ffauth or the brentith, and of Scotland the thire and fiftith. **Between us** Walter Yonge Esquier, John Weston, Robert Warswelle gentleman, John Peete  
Robert Bucknolle, John Buttler, Hugh Newton, Stephen Bird & Simon Vyse, comen, of Coliton in the County of Devon of late. And John Carwill, Joseph Longe & John Tuckling  
of Coliton aforesaid gentlemen of thys place. **Whereas** the said Walter Yonge, John Weston, Robert Warswelle, John Peete, Robert Bucknolle, John Buttler, Hugh Newton, Stephen  
Bird and Simon Vyse nowe stande & are bounde to hym & to his wifes of Coliton aforesaid all & singuler thing  
whiche to the Office of a Clerk of the Mackett doth belonche or appertaynt from tyme to tyme for ever. And also of & in the Court of Dipowders there, as to ffauces & Mackett is  
commonly vsed within the Realme of England. And of & in all casuallies profits issued & emoluments whatsoeuer in the said Court of Dipowders concerning coming or arisynge. **Nowe**  
the Indenture witnesseth that the said Walter Yonge, John Weston, Robert Warswelle, John Peete, Robert Bucknolle, John Buttler, Hugh Newton, Stephen Bird &  
Simon Vyse, wch haue had & consent of William Drake, Robert Bragge, Henry Wainwood, John Ham, Robert ffarrant gentleman, George Marty, John Buckland, Gregorie  
Campion, ffrauncis Bagwell, Ralph Tapte, John Wymaton, Edward Holwill, Walter Marty & John Sampson the younger being the more part of the Twentie men of  
Coliton aforesaid. **Hauing** for divers god causes & Consideracions them heretunto mobinge given graunted & confirmed and by these presente Doc for them & their heires  
gues & graunt & seffesse and confirmed unto the said John Warswelle, Joseph Longe and John Tuckling & to them & to their heires for ever, all the said Authoritie & power to doe &  
dictate wch in the wifc aforesaid all & singuler thinge wch to the Office of a Clerk of the Mackett doth belonche or appertaynt from tyme to tyme for ever. And also the said  
Court of Dipowders & keeping of the same there, as to ffauces & Mackett is commonely vsed wch in the Realme of England. And all casuallies profits issued & emoluments  
whatsoeuer in the said Court of Dipowders concerning coming or arisynge. **To haue and to hold** the said Authoritie & power and Court of Dipowders  
aforesaid and all & singuler other he wifcs before specified wch haue had & consent of the said John Warswelle, Joseph Longe & John Tuckling & to them & to their  
heires for ever. Upon & confidence & trust that he issued & profits wch shall arise & growe of the wifcs from tyme to tyme shall be giben & employed to e for thenselvys and benefitt of the poore of the  
place aforesaid. **And** the said John Warswelle, Joseph Longe and John Tuckling do voluntarily graunt & agree stably and respetuallie each of them for himself his heires  
executors administrators & assignes to e wch the said Walter Yonge, John Weston, Robert Warswelle, John Peete, Robert Bucknolle, John Buttler, Hugh Newton, Stephen  
Bird & Simon Vyse & either of them, his & either of hem heires executors administrators & assignes by these presente. That at any tyme ad thys shalbe but on son  
of hem he said John Warswelle, Joseph Longe and John Tuckling living, That hem he said son living shall vpon reasonable request unto him to bee made in that behalfe  
by the said Twentie men of the said wifc nowe being or wch hereafter shalbe or the most part of them give graunt & seffesse and confirm the said Authoritie and  
power and all & singuler other he wifcs unto such other person or persons of the wifc of Coliton aforesaid as shalbe nominated and appointed by the said Twentie men or the  
most part of hem, vpon heire like confidence and trust as aforesaid. **In witnessesse** whereof the said parties to these presente haue to the same Interchangeable  
putt their handes & sealed vpon the daies and yeres first abovewritten. 1622.
