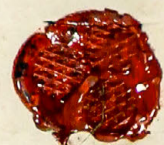


This Indenture

made the seventh day of September in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and twenty nine *Between*
John Otton of Wotton Fitzpaine in the County of Dorset Gentleman of the one part and William Templor Pole Baronet
Frederick Barnes Doctor of Divinity William Payne James Kingdon Leveux Glade Symes John Snook Joseph Scobell
Richard Kittle Jacob Pady and Charles Northam Gentlemen surviving Trustees of the Parish Lands of Colyton in the County of Devon of the other part *Whereas* by Indenture of
Feoffment bearing date on or about the fifteenth day of May One thousand eight hundred and twelve and made between James Spurway therein described of the one part and the said John Otton
of the other and by Livery of Seign made according to the form and effect thereof a Memorandum whereof is thereupon endorsed the Lands Tenements and Hereditaments hereinafter described
were enfeoffed and conveyed unto and to the use of the said John Otton his Heirs and Assigns for ever *And Whereas* the said William Templor Pole Frederick Barnes William Payne James
Kingdon Leveux Glade Symes John Snook Joseph Scobell Richard Kittle Jacob Pady and Charles Northam have contracted and agreed with the said John Otton for the sale to them of the said Premises
at or for the price or sum of One hundred and five Pounds and the same is now intended to be enfeoffed and conveyed in the manner hereinafter mentioned *Now this Indenture Witnesseth*
that for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and five Pounds of lawful Money of Great Britain to the said John Otton in hand well and truly paid at or before the sealing and
delivery of these Presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged *He* the said John Otton *doth* granted and enfeoffed and by these Presents *doth* give grant enfeoffe and confirm unto
the said William Templor Pole Frederick Barnes William Payne James Kingdon Leveux Glade Symes John Snook Joseph Scobell Richard Kittle Jacob Pady and Charles Northam and their Successors
All that piece or Plot of Land formerly a Garden lying opposite to the Dwelling House and Shop late in the occupation of the said James Spurway since of Richard Kittle and now of Nicodemus Otton
bounded on the South by the Street on the North by Lands belonging to the said Feoffees on the East by the School house and on the West by the Churchyard together with all erections and Buildings
thereupon and the Reversion and Reversionary Remainder and Remainders Rents Issues and Profits thereof and all the Estate Right Title Interest Claim and Demand whatsoever both at Law and in Equity or
otherwise howsoever of him the said John Otton in to or respecting the same or any part thereof *Do have and to hold* the said Piece or Plot of Land and Premises with their and every of their Rights
Members and Appurtenances and all and singular other the Premises hereby granted enfeoffed and confirmed or mentioned or intended so to be and every part thereof unto and to the use of
the said William Templor Pole Frederick Barnes William Payne James Kingdon Leveux Glade Symes John Snook Joseph Scobell Richard Kittle Jacob Pady and Charles Northam and their
Successors *In Trust* to fulfil and perform such Intent and Purposes as by the major part of the Twenty Men of the Parish of Colyton then nominated for the time being shall be declared
devised and that when but Three of the said Feoffees shall be surviving they shall upon request of the said Twenty Men convey the said Premises to such other Persons of the Parish of Colyton
as shall be nominated by the said Twenty Men for the time being for the Purposes aforesaid *And* the said John Otton doth hereby grant for himself and his Heirs that he and they
shall and will warrant and for ever defend unto and to the use of the said William Templor Pole Frederick Barnes Barnes William Payne James Kingdon Leveux Glade Symes
John Snook Joseph Scobell Richard Kittle Jacob Pady and Charles Northam and their Successors all and every the said Lands Hereditaments and Premises against him the said
John Otton and his Heirs and against all and every other Person and Persons whomsoever *In Witness* whereof the said Parties to these Presents have hereunto set their Hands
