

To all **Whome** these presents shall come **John White** of Shute in the County of Devon yoman and **Thomas his wife** do hereby greeting. **Howe** **ever** that woe the said **John White** and **Thomas his wife** for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred sterlings five pounds five shillings and 8^d of good and lawfull money of England sold or come of lbs in hand paid. The receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and for other dry good cause and considerations to hereunto moving. **Have** **con** **vised** **re** **leased** **and** **qu** **ite** **cl** **ay** **med** and by these presents do and either of us doth severally and absolutely remise release and quite clayme unto **Christiam Stouring** of Chanton in the said County Camor being in his full and perfect possession and seign and to his heirs and assigns for ever all our and either of our right title interest woe in and about and about of Couduant clayme and demand whatsoever which woe or either of us or our or either of our respective heirs exors^{rs} or administrato^{rs} or any of them at any tyme had now have or hereafter by any means may have of and in or concerning all that Mesuage and Tenement with filage tenements situate lying and being in Chanton otherwise Compton within the parish of Shute aforesaid in the said County of Devon was in the tenure possession or occupation of the said **Christiam Stouring** his tenants or assigns and of or concerning the houses edifices buildings Courts Courtilages Gardens Orchardes lands meadows pastures feedings Trees woods Underwoods wayes paths water water courses gasements cisterns Comodities molmills and hereditaments whatsoever in Chanton or Shute aforesaid or elsewhere but the said Mesuage and Tenement or any part thereof incident belonging or in any wise appertaining or now or heretofore accepted taken or known or used occupied or enjoyed or with the same as part parcel or member thereof or of any part thereof soe as neither woe the said **John White** and **Thomas his wife** or either of us nor any other person or persons whatsoever for us or in our or either of our names respectively any right title interest clayme or demand whatsoever of or in the said Mesuage Tenement and filage or any part thereof with thappentances hereafter shall or may clayme challenge or demand. But of and from all and every action of Couduant right title interest clayme and demand of in and to or concerning the same and every part thereof with thappentances shall be utterly barred and excluded for ever by these presents and the said **John White** and his heirs all and singular the same with thappentances unto the said **Christiam Stouring** his heirs and assigns against him the said **John White** and **Thomas his wife** and his heirs of the said **John White** and all other person and persons whatsoever shall and will warrant argue and defend by these presents. **In witness** whereof the parties above named to these presents their hands and seals notwithstanding have set
