

This Indenture

Made the thirtieth day of September in the fourteenth year of the reign of our most glorious Foreraigne Lord Charles the first by the grace of God of England Scotland France and Ireland King Defender of the faith etc. Betweene John White of Shute in the County of Devon Yeoman and Thomas his wife of thone part and Wisbrom Stonyng of Kenyton in the same County tenant of thother part witnesses that aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of **Three hundred** pounds of good and lawfull money of England unto them by the said Wisbrom Stonyng before the sealing and delivery of these presents well and lawfully satisfied contented and paid the sum whereof is hereby acknowledged and therof and of every part and part thereof they the said John White and Thomas his wife doe and either of them doth hereby acquit release and discharge the said Wisbrom Stonyng his heirs executors and administrators and every of them for ever by these presents as also for the extinguishing of all titles doer and estates for life or in the residue lands and hereditaments hereafter mentioned with their tenants John White and Thomas his wife for themselves and either of them and their and either of their heirs executors and administrators and for every of them doe and either of them doth covenant promise and agree to and with the said Wisbrom Stonyng his heirs and assigns by these presents that they the said John White and Thomas his wife at the next assize or assizes which shall be in the year of our lord god one thousand five hundred sixty and seven acknowledge and determine in due forme of lawe according to the Common Courte of shires in such case used unto the said Wisbrom Stonyng of all that residue and tenement with their tenants situated being and being in Kenyton also Kenyton tenants or assigns and of all and singular the houses edifices courtlages gardens orchards lanes meadows houses pastures stonings woods and woods common profits commodities hereditaments whatsoever unto the said residue and tenement or to any part thereof belonging or in any wise appertaining by the name and names of the residue former gardens or orchards tenements of land or acres of meadow meadow or pasture with their tenants in Kenyton also Kenyton or situate in the County of Devon or by the name or by any other name or names whatsoever and that the same doe to be conveyed shall be and cure to and for the only use and behoofe of the said Wisbrom Stonyng his heirs and assigns for ever
