aforesaid late in the tenure or possession of John white my deceased Husband and  
of and in all the houses, messuages, Courtlans, Gardens, Orchards, Land  
meadows, Leashes, pastures, Wooding, Common, profits, commodities and hereditaments  
whatsoever with their appertanances unto the said Morsage and Tenement or to any part  
therof belonging or in any wise appertaining, So as that neither of the said Ellen  
white nor any other person or persons for me, or in my name any right title claime  
interest or Demand of or in the said Morsage Tenement and pmisses or any part  
therof with the appertanances hereafter shall or may claime challenge or Demand  
But of and from all and every action of right title claime, interest and Demand of  
in and to the pmisses and every part therof with the appertanances shall be utterly  
barred and excluded by these presents **Witness** wherof of the said Ellen  
white have hereunto set my hand and seale upon the thre and twentieth day of  
March in the year of our Lord God one thousand six hundred ffortie and nine
