aforesaid late in the tyme of possession of John White my deade husband and
of me and in all the houses, daffes, tinctures, Courtlynes, Gardnes, Orchardys, landys,
meadowes, leasnes, pastures ffeodinge, Comous, profitte, remodities and hereditaments,
whatsoever with their appertenances unto the said Mosenage and tenement or to any part
thereof belonging or in any wise appertayning, So as that neither of the said Ellen
White nor any other person or persons for me, or in my name quy right title, clame
interest or domaun of me in the said Mosenage tenement and p[ar]ishes or any part
therof with the appertenances, hereafter shall or may clame thaloufe, or domaun
But of me and from all and every attion of right title, clame, interest and domaun of me
in and to the p[ar]ishes and every part therof with the appertenances, shall be setteth
barred and excludeth by these present G^r iurties wherof the said Ellen
White haue herunto sett my hand and seale upon the thre and twentyeth day of
March in the yere of our lord God One thousand six hundred fforde and inno
