dayes in the year of our Lord one thousand six hundred fifty five before the Hon^{ble} Justices Sir John Edward Atkins
Matthew Hale & Hugh Wyndham Justices & others then & there present between John Smyth & Nicholas
Sligg p^{ts} And John White & Thomas his wife before of one messuage one barn one stable one garden
one orchard eight acres of land nynd acres of meadow & eight acres of pasture wth the appurtenances in
Whitford & Shute whereupon a plea of Servant was summoned between them in the said Court that
is to say that the aforesaid John White & Thomas have acknowledged the aforesaid tenements wth the
appurtenances to be the right of him the said John Smyth As those wth the said John & Nicholas have of
the gift of the aforesaid John White & Thomas And those they have renised & quitclaimed from them
the said John White & Thomas & their heires to the aforesaid John Smyth & Nicholas & the heires of the
said John for ever And moreover the said John White & Thomas have granted for them & the heires of the
said John that they will warrant to the aforesaid John Smyth & Nicholas & the heires of the said John the
aforesaid tenements wth the appurtenances against them the said John White & Thomas & the heires of
the said John for ever And for this acknowledgement renise quitclaim warranty fine & agreement the said
John Smyth & Nicholas have given to the aforesaid John White & Thomas forty & one pounds 10⁰ 11⁰ 01⁰
sterlinge.
