This is the final Agreement made in the Court of the Honourable Bench at Weston from Easter day in fifteen
days in the year of our Lord one thousand five hundred fifty five before Oliver St John Edward Allynus
Matthew Hale & Hugh Wyndham Justices & others then & there present Betweene John Smythe & Nicholas
Eligg plets and John White & Thomasine his wife before us of one messuage and barn & one stable one garden
and orchard eight acres of land myd' acres of meadow & eight acres of pasture with the appurtenances in Weston
Whitford & Shute Water upon a plea of Covenant was sumoned betweene them in the said Court that
is to say that the aforesaid John White & Thomasine have acknowledged the aforesaid tenents with the
appurtenances to be the right of him the said John Smythe as those were the said John & Nicholas have of
the gift of the aforesaid John White & Thomasine and those they have received & quietclaimed from them
the said John White & Thomasine & their heires to the aforesaid John Smythe & Nicholas & the heires of the
said John for ever And moreover the said John White & Thomasine have granted for them & the heires of the
said John that they will warrant to the aforesaid John Smythe & Nicholas & the heires of the said John the
aforesaid tenement with the appurtenances against them the said John White & Thomasine & the heires of
the said John for ever and for this acknowledging receipt quicllaine warranty find & Agreed the said
John Smythe & Nicholas have given to the aforesaid John White & Thomasine forty & one pounds Westm
sterling.
