Palmer and William Baker but then and for many Years last past in the Possession of the said Richard Salter of the Tenure of Old Barton but not subject to the yearly Rent of six pence
Three farthings payable thereout and out of certain other Lands or any part thereof except the Commons common of Pasture waste Lands and Commonable Places within the said Manor of
Ottery Saint Mary if any belonging to the said Premises as therein mentioned ANNO the said Close of Land and Premises with its Appurtenances thereby granted and
