and adnow to be paid done and performed **Have** Demised sett and to farm lett and by these presents **To** by the consent and approbation of the said twenty Men or the Major part of them as aforesaid Demise sett and to farm lett unto the said Collan Warrington All that Building called the Shambles Situate in the Town of Colyton aforesaid with the appurtenances and the Market Place and the fairs and Markets there kept with all and all manner of sole custom and staleage whatsoever to the said Fairs and Markets belonging or have or hath been usually had or enjoyed by any former Tenant or Tenants therof And also that part of the Market house wherein the Boards Poles and Trussells belonging to the said Fairs and Markets now are kept together with the use of those said Boards Poles and Trussells **To have and To hold** all and singular the said Premises hereby Demised or intended to be with the appurtenances unto the said Collan Warrington his Esq; Admrs and assigns from the twenty fifth day of March last past and during the full time and term of years Years from thence next ensuing and fully to be compleat and Ended **Yielding** and paying therefore yearly and every year during the said term unto the said feoffees their successors and assigns the annual or yearly rent of thirtynoon pounds and six shillings of lawfull Money of Great Britain by Equal Quarterly payments to be made on four of the most Usual Feasts or days of Payment in the Year (that is to say) the twenty fourth day of June the twenty ninth day of September the twenty fifth day of December and the twenty fifth day of March by even and Equal Portions the first Quarterly payment to be made and begin on the twenty fourth day of this instant June **And** the said Collan Warrington doth hereby for himself his Esq; Admrs and assigns covenant promise and agree to and with the said feoffees their successors and assigns in manner following (that is to say) that he the said Collan Warrington his Esq; Admrs and assigns shall and will make and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said feoffees their successors and assigns the said yearly rent above reserved at the several and respective days and times and in manner and form abovementioned for payment thereof according to the true intent and meaning of these Presents **And** the said John Sampson Thomas Drake Edward Squire Sir George Yonge James Marwood Francis Drake John Sampson the Younger Samuel Sampson Thomas Drake the Younger James Gushy Thomas Hoskins and Philip Michell Do hereby for themselves their successors and assigns Covenant promise and agree to and with the said Collan Warrington his Esq; Admrs and assigns that they the said feoffees their successors and assigns shall and will from time to time and at all times hereafter during the said term hereby Granted well and sufficiently repair and keepe the said Shambles and Market house in all needfull and necessary reparations when and as often as need shall require And also that they the said feoffees their successors and assigns shall and will at all times during the said term hereby Granted bear Pay and Discharge or abate Deduct and allow out of the said yearly rent hereby reserved all rates and Taxes whatsoever wherewith the said Presentes shall or may be charged or chargeable **Provided** always nevertheless and howe ever these Presentes are upon this Express Condition that if it shall happen that the said yearly rent above reserved or any part thereof to be behind and unpaid in part or in the whole by the space of twenty eight Days next after either of the said Days and times whereon the same ought to be paid as aforesaid being lawfully demanded and then not paid and no sufficient Distress thereon to be found whereby to levy the same with the arrowidg of the same (if any shall happen to be) **That** then and from thenceforth it shall and may be lawful to and for the said feoffees their successors and assigns into the said Demised premises or into any part thereof in the name of the whole to enter and the same to have again reposse and Enjoy as in his and their first and former Estate anything herein contained to the contrary notwithstanding **And Lastly** that he the said Collan Warrington his Esq; Admrs and assigns shall and may from time to time and at all times during the term hereby Granted by and under the yearly rent Covenants and Agreements herein contained on his and their parts to be paid done and performed peaceably and quietely enter into have hold occupy & possess and enjoy all and singular the said Premises hereby Demised with the appurtenances without any trouble hindrance or detayll of any by them the said feoffees their successors and assigns or of any other person or persons whatsoever **In Witness** whereof the parties first aforesaid named to these Presents their hands and seals interchangeably have set the day of the year first above written AD
