HIS INDENTURE made the Bne' and Euerie h' day of October in the year of the reigne of our soveraigne Lord Charles the second King of England, Scotland, France and Ireland, Defender of the faith, & anno 1670.

Thousand six hundred and fourtie Robert Starkant, Peter Blasballer, Walter Rye, Richard Weston, Francis Bagwell, Peter Linton, Phillip Mithell, John Hallon, John Shurber, John Basleigh and Peter Seller feoffees of the pish lands of Colston in the County of Avon to And Edmond Thalond of Bowd in the pish of Colston in the County of Devon. In q' of the other pto **WITNESSETH** that we Robert Starkant, Peter Blasballer, Walter Rye, Richard Weston, Francis Bagwell, Peter Linton, Phillip Mithell, John Hallon, John Shurber, John Basleigh and Peter Seller feoffees aforesaid have sent and sent of William Arleffester Barstall, John Holmest, Thomas Holme, Edward Pratt, Stephen Bid, Willmolas, Barnipon, John Abbott, John Day, Benet, Scarle, Bernard Bright, John Clepp and Phillip Cox and the rest of the gentlemen of the pish of Colston aforesaid and in Consideration of the yearly rent hereafter named by these persons mentioned and reserved to be paid to the said feoffees their heirs or assigns. **Harre** demised granted and to farme lette and by these presents doth demise grant and to farme all in the pish monde of Thalond his Countys and assignes all thos' true poors of meadow ground in their appertences lying in a thalere called or benn by the name of Southover in the pish of Colston aforesaid and was late in the forme of incorporation of one John Barstall of Colston aforesaid went Adread Tonay ringe in the whole his estimatione one and ha' they more or lesse. The one of these poors is bounded on the other Lands of the said Edmond Thalond in the south west and the lands of John Clepp went in the north east and the lands of Alexander Gaite in the east and south east and the other poore is also bounded to the other lands of the said Edmond Thalond q' and one Robert Morham in the south and south west pte other the lands of John Rye q' in the West pte and the lands of Thomas Holme in the east pte and the lands of Stortiles spring in the North pte EXCEPT and always reserved out of this demised and grant unto the said feoffees their heirs and assignes free libertie of ingresso et regresso attant to the same tyme and tymes into wyxen and from the premises for the veyninge and surveyinge of the same. **To harre and to hold** all thos' poors aforesaid of Meadow ground in their appertences except before excepted unto the said Edmond Thalond his executors, administrators and assignes immediately from and after the said and first day of March next ensuinge and fully to be to implout payed and indebted Edmond Thalond during his life and Brit Thalond son and daughters of the said Edmond Thalond bearing credit of them to longe shall happen to live **yealdinre** and payinge therfore yearly and duly yarde duringe the same unto the said feoffees their heirs and assignes the sume or yearly rent of this seconde shillinges and pence vns of laundseyng of England at the house most usall fleshe or bones in the year of Christ is to saye at the feaste of the nativitie of s' John the Battist. Mithall the birth of o' Lord God and remanuacione of His blessed Virgin Mary, by even and equall portions. **And if it** shall happen that the said yearly rent shall be behinde and unpaid in pte or in all by the space of one quarter of a yarde next after any of the aforesaid feastes in wch is to saye thought to be paid the same beinge lawfull demande and then not paid and too sufficient distresse and upon the premises in the mean tymes tyme tare or may be found for the longing of the same that then and therefor the same shall and may be lawfull tare for the said feoffees their heirs and assignes and by of them into all and singuler the said demised poise in their application to recoure and the same to have againste retaine and enjoy as in their first and former estate these poise whiche in the contrary in any wise not standinge. **And if the** Robert Starkant, Peter Blasballer, Walter Rye, Richard Weston, Francis Bagwell, Peter Seller, Phillip Mithell, John Hallon, John Shurber, John Basleigh and Peter Seller feoffees aforesaid their heirs all the aforesaid poise and by of them appertences (except before excepted) unto the said Edmond Thalond his executors, administrators and assignes in manner and forme aforesaid and under the aforesaid conditions to be expressed and reserved aforesaid aginst the high Lordes of the pish of Colston for all heighrents, suites and services to these poise and payable for the same as also aginst themselves their feoffees and their heirs and assignes and by of them shall and will warrant acquitt and defend by these presents duringe the same **IN WITNESSE** witness of the pish of Bowd named to these indentures their hands and seals interchangingably hanfft the day and year as it abode written.
