The Contract and agreement then made by and betwixt Edward  
Boards of Loughayne in the parish of Colyton in the County of  
Dorset yeoman of the one pte and Francis Bagwell Richard  
Newton and Peter Soller as well on the amount of them  
solvers as also on the amount of the rest of the Hooffoos  
and Twentie men of the parish lands of the parish of Colyton  
aforesaid of the other pte are followeth to wit

First that the Hooffoos & Twentie men of the said parish of  
Colyton in consideration of the summe of six hundred pounds yearly  
and only yearly by quarterly paym<sup>ts</sup> to be paid to the said Edward  
Boards duringe the terme of his naturall life by the said  
Hooffoos & Twentie men that they the said Hooffoos and Twentie  
men shall have and take the estate of Loughayne  
Brideshayes & being Downe west w<sup>ch</sup> they appertaine in the parish  
of Colyton aforesaid for and duringe all the remainder of the  
estate w<sup>ch</sup> the said Edward Boards hath or might have  
by vertue of any former lease granted by the former Hooffoos  
for the aforesaid estate and the lease shall surrender and  
yours self into the hands of the said Hooffoos for the use of  
them the said Hooffoos their heirs or assigns  
provided the said Hooffoos shall abst<sup>ain</sup> of any Ten<sup>er</sup> for  
the said p<sup>ar</sup>se or any p<sup>ar</sup> thereof for lease or years  
In witness whereof the said Edward Boards hand  
and seale was sett my hand and seale the Two and Twentieth  
day of November in the year of o<sup>ur</sup> Lord God 1683. //
