

His Indenture made the ninth day of October in the two and sixtieth year of the reign of our sovereign lord Charles the second King of England or **Betwene** Francis Baywell Richard Norton Phillip Mitchell John Whistler Peter Cleton and Peter Seller **offices** of the high Lands of Colyton in the County of Devon upon the one part And Maryeott Kerke of Colyton in the high Lands of Colyton also said third of the other part **Witnesseth** that the said **officer** Francis Baywell Richard Norton Phillip Mitchell John Whistler Peter Cleton and Peter Seller by and in the presence before of Master George Bart William Drake gent and the rest of the **wardens** men of the high Lands of Colyton aforesaid for and in consideration of the summe of six and monie pounds of lawfull money of England unto the said **officer** by the said Maryeott Kerke before the sealinge and delivery thereof mowt and twenty pds the receipt wherof they the said **officer** do hereby acknowledge haue demised leased granted and let same letting and by these presents dooing present and to have full power and licence to all manner of dwellinge house on the said garden and ground of said Maryeott Kerke Mowt or dwelinge house on the said garden and ground in and therunto adioyninge and belonginge containinge by estimation in one Burrough land to the Lordes of John Hawkes and in the North to the Landes of John Gandy and the Kings highway in the South and late was in the use or occupancy of Edward Kerke deceased my husband of the said Maryeott together with all wayes and passages to the same belonginge or in anywise appertayninge except and alwayes reserved out of this present demise and grant unto the said **officer** their heirs and assignes free liberty of imprese except as alwayes reserved to the said **officer** their heirs and assignes for the neyng and surveyng of the same or any part thereof and rooyalty of all tyme convenient unto upon and from the first day for the neyng and surveyng of the same or any part thereof to haue and to hold all the said Mowt or dwelinge house on the said garden as well of Land and everye thinge appertayning thereto in that tyme (except before excepted) unto the said Maryeott Kerke her executors and assignes immediately from and after the day of the date hereof for all tyme of houses and mowt come yearly from hence next ensuinge and fully to be compleat, expied and ended by her the said Maryeott Kerke and Joane Kerke her children or any other of them seconde shall happen to live. **Yealdinge** and payng the said yearly and everye year unto the said **officer** their heirs and assignes the summe or yearly rent of two shillings of lawfull money at the said most vniuersall feasts or times in the year that is to say at the fest of the Birth of our Lord God and the nativitie of the blessed Virgin Mary S John the Baptist and S Michael the archangell by even and equal parts duringe the said tyme. **And** also yealdinge and payng after the death of any of them the said Maryeott Kerke Joane Kerke and Joane Kerke dyng successively as they are named the summe of two shillings and four pence of lawfull money for ever the name of a heriot or farts to be alreadys due and payable to the chyf Lordes of the said thre and all Burrough rents and other dues to be yearly payng out of the same duringe the said tyme. **And** the said Maryeott Kerke for herself her executors and assignes doth bounynge and agreeing to and with the said Francis Baywell Richard Norton Phillip Mitchell John Whistler Peter Cleton and Peter Seller their heirs and assignes and every of them by these presents that her executors and assignes shall and will from tyme to tyme and at all tymes hereafter duringe the said tyme well and sufficiellty repair sustayne and mayntayne all the said demised premises and encompasse there of in the plattis of small in wallinge, ymberinge, thatching and bordinge and also in hedged and ditched as in all other needfull and necessary reparacions whatsoever when and as often as need shall require, And in the end of the said tyme the same premises so well and sufficiellty in all things repaired and mayntayned shall be left and yealded uppon and toward the reparacions whereof it shall and may be lawfull to and for the said Maryeott Kerke her executors and assignes to haue and take upon the same tyme or tyme if it shall be found to be had more conuenient for the reparacions of the premises aforesaid by the assyment and delivry of the said **officer** or their layfesse for the tyme beinge. **But** if it shall happen that the said yearly rent of two shillings shall be behinde and unpaid by the space of eight and twentie dayes next after any of the said feasts in the same ought to be payed tyme lawfully demandyd and then not payed and no sufficient distresse made upon the premises or any part thereof can or may be found for the levyinge of the said rent in charenges if any happen to be. **Or** if the said Maryeott Kerke her executors and assignes or any of them shall willingly do or by her or their agent or servant susee he done any affronte thinge or things whatsoever to the said premises or any part thereof to the said **officer** their heirs and assignes. **Or** if the said Maryeott Kerke her executors and assignes or any of them shall doe or comitt any voluntary wast in and upon the premises or any part thereof to the valye of two shillings or upwards and shall not sufficiellty amend the same withinforty dayes next after warininge thereof to beginynge at the said house by the said **officer** their heirs and assignes either of them or their layfesse for the tyme beinge. **Or** shall give graunt sett lett and assignes over the said house and other the premises or any part thereof to any person or persons in charene or ther to the said premises and Joane Kerke her children or either of them in contynent and goodwill of the more part of the said **officer** and **wardens** in writinge under their hands and seals first had and obtained. That then and att all tymes from thence forth for every or any of the said cause it shall and may be lawfull to and for the said **officer** their heirs and assignes and every of them into the said house and all and singuler other the premises houses demised in the plattis to reenter and the said to have againe retayne and enioy as in their first and former state these **wardens** or any thinge therin contained to the contrary thereof in anywise mervestandinge. **And** the said Francis Baywell Richard Norton Phillip Mitchell John Whistler Peter Cleton and Peter Seller for themselves their heirs and assignes and for every of them dooing and paying to and with the said Maryeott Kerke her executors and assignes that she the said Maryeott Kerke her executors and assignes and every of them in manner and forme aforesaid and before expressed aswell as the high Lordes of the place thereof for all relesse to them the said high Lordes due and payable for the same as also against them to do the said **officer** their heirs and assignes shall and will warrant attynge and defend by these presents duringe the said tyme. **In witness** wherof the said **wardens** above named have to those presents indented sett their hands and sealed the day and yere first abouenwritten. 1680.
