

This Indenture made the eighth day of December anno Domini 1708
Between Benjamin French now of Seaton in the County of Devon gentleman and Mary his
wife of the said parish and Nathan Marwood of Colyton in the County aforesaid Cordwainer of the
said parish Whereas to Benjamin French in regard of his said Mary his wife or else together
with his said Mary who is Administratrix of his goods and Chattels of William W. Geman late Pro
bent is and shall be legally entitled and interested of the same premises heremafter mentioned for the
remainder of a Term of four years and six months years to comeable on the death of Simon W. Geman
of Portsmeale in the County of Southampton another brother of his said Mary which premises were formerly
purchased by John W. Geman deceased late Esq: of his said Mary William and Simon W. Geman
of C from his Foffees for the sum of £1000 value of the said lands of Colyton aforesaid and are now in the possession
of his said Nathan Marwood **Issue** of debts that his said Benjamin French &
Mary his wife for and in Consideration of the sum of five pounds and ten shillings law full money of Great
Britain to him his said Benjamin French in hand paid by his said Nathan Marwood at and before the execution
of this indenture, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged **Bath** granted bargained sold assigned and
confirmed and by his presents the said Benjamin French and Mary his wife Doe and each of them Dole
granted bargain sold assigned and confirmed unto his said Nathan Marwood his executors and assigns all that Orchard
commonly called or known by the name of Wring Orchard situated in the Burrough of Fullford within the
parish of Colyton containing one acre and one Rod more or less now in the possession of his said Nathan
Marwood as heria before mentioned and all wayes and places waters watercours easements profits priviledges
enclousments and appurtenances thereto belonging and all the estate right title interest term of
years party claim and demand whatsoever by Law and in Equity of him the said Benjamin
French and Mary his wife and either of them of him and unto his premises called Dode and Whistings
relating thereto. **To have and to hold** the said Orchard and premises unto the
appurtenances unto his said Nathan Marwood his executors and assigns from time forth for and during all
such time and estate and in as large a summire manner as his said Benjamin French
and Mary his wife or either of them might or should have held and enjoy the same digital Law or in
Equity by any wayes or means whatsoever. By and under payement of the rents and services of the said premises
forefirst due payable and payable by force of the original lease thereof granted by his said Foffees to
his said John W. Geman deceased. **And** the said Benjamin French for himself and his said Mary his wife
and either of them and digital of his said executors and assigns and every of them Doth covenant and agree
to and with his said Nathan Marwood his executors and assigns by his presents that it shall and may be lawfull
to and for his said Nathan Marwood his executors and assigns from time forth for and during all such time and
estate as aforesaid previously and quietly to have held and enjoy his said Orchard and premises unto his appurtenances
without any lawfull suit trouble or demayle of or by his said Benjamin French and Mary his wife or
either of them or any other person or persons claiming or to claim by from or under him or either of them
or his said William W. Geman deceased by him or either of them acts with priuity convey or otherwise.
