HIS Indenture

Made the Thirteenth Day of November in the first Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord George the Third by the Grace of God of all Great Britain, France and Ireland King Defender of the Islands and Seaford and in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven hundred and Sixty Three
 William Watson Esquire John Sampson Gentleman Thomas Drake Gentleman John Bailey Gentleman and Edward Squire Yeoman surviving Heofees
 of the Parish Lands of Culliton in the County of Devon of the one part and Robert Pykes of Culliton within the parish of Culliton aforesaid Yeoman of the other part. WITNESSETH that the said Heofees by and with the Consent of the Survivors of the Twenty Acre of the Parish Chamber of Culliton aforesaid Clerks and Chosen for All and Assistant to the said Heofees and in Consideration of the sum of Six and Twenty pounds of Good and Lawfull money of Great Britain to the said Heofees in hand paid by the said Robert Pykes at or before the Sealing and Delivery hereof the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged To the said Heofees by and with the Consent of the Survivors of the said Twenty Acre HAVE Promised Granted and to have Lesten and by these presents
 To Promise Grant and to have Let unto the said Robert Pykes All that Messuage or Dwelling House with the Barn Outhouses Garden and Pannel of Land thereunto Belonging and a
 adjoining Containing by estimation One Borough Acre (or the same more or less) Situate lying and Being within the Borough of Culliton aforesaid now in the possession of the said Robert Pykes and all ways passages Waters Waterourses Watering places Easements profits Commodities Advantages and Appurtenances whatsoever to the said Messuage or Dwelling House and premises belonging or in anywise appertaining Except and always reserved out of this present Premise and Grant unto the said Heofee and the Survivors of them Successors or Assigns all and all manner of Timber Trees Young Trees Bumps and Saplings now standing growing and being or which shall or may hereafter stand grow or be in or upon the said Premises premises or any part or parcel thereof with free liberty of ingress Egress and Regress to and from the said Heofees and the Survivors of them Successors or Assigns Servants Agents or Workmen to pass and Repass over through and upon the said Premises and every part and parcel thereof so to have and to hold Culliton Pigg Root work up plant transplant and with all manner of carriages take and carry away any trees Bumps and Saplings thereon growing at all seasonable and convenient times and also liberty of hunting Hawking fishing and shooting To have and to hold the said Messuage or Dwelling House and premises aforesaid and every part and parcel thereof with their and each and every of their Appurtenances Except before Excepted unto the said Robert Pykes his executors Administrators or Assigns from the Day of the Death hereof for and during and unto the full end and term of twenty five years henceforth next and immediately ensuing and fully to be Complete and ended If the said Robert Pykes Anne Bole of Culliton aforesaid Spinster and Joseph Baulk son of Elizabeth Baulk of Culliton aforesaid Widow either of the said Robert Pykes or any or either of them shall so long happen to live Hying and Dying and
 and every year during the said term hereby granted unto the said Heofees or the Survivors of them Successors or Assigns the Rent or sum of Two Shillings of Good and Lawfull Money of Great Britain at Rent of the most usual Heasts or Days of payment in the Year (that is to say) the Year of the Nativity of our Lord Christ the Annunciation of the Blessed Virgin Mary Saint John the Baptist and Saint Michael the Archangel by even and equal portions the first of the said payments to be made and begin on the Year of the Nativity of our Lord Christ next ensuing the date hereof And also Hying and Dying and
 and immediately upon the said Heofees or the Survivors of them Successors or Assigns at and immediately upon the several Deaths and Decesses of them the said Robert Pykes Anne Bole and Joseph Baulk the sum of Three Shillings and four pence of like Lawfull Money of Great Britain for and in the Name of an Heriot And likewise yielding and paying all heach rents payable to the Lord or Lords of the Fee of the said
 Premises and all Borough rents and others dues, dutes yearly to become due and payable out of the same during the said term And also doing Suit and Service to all and every of the Court and Courts
 Meeting and Meetings of the said Heofees or the Survivors of them Successors or Assigns which shall during the term hereby granted be helden and kept in the Parish Chamber of Culliton aforesaid upon reasonable summons and Warning as often the Tenants of the said Parish Lands do or have accustomed to do And the said Robert Pykes for himself his executors Administrators and Assigns and for every of them
 doth Covenant promise and Agree to and with the said Heofees and the Survivors of them Successors and Assigns by these presents that the said Robert Pykes his executors Administrators and Assigns shall and will during the term hereby granted at his or their own proper Costs and Charges well and sufficiently repair amend maintain sustain and keep the said Premised Messuage or Dwelling House and
 premises and every part and parcel thereof with their Appurtenances in all manner of needfull and necessary reparations whatsoever when and as often as need shall require and the same so well and in
 sufficiently repaired amended maintained sustained and kept as the end of the said term shall and will leave and yield up unto the said Heofees or the Survivors of them Successors or Assigns quickly
 and in peace And also that the said Robert Pykes his executors Administrators and Assigns shall and will pay bear and discharge all and all manner of Public Rates Taxes Assessments and other such
 impositions and payments whatsoever as well extraordinary as ordinary which at any time or times hereafter during the said term hereby granted shall or maybe charged taxed or imposed in or upon the said Heofees or any part or parcel thereof And if it shall happen that the said yearly Rent or sum of two Shillings or any part thereof shall be delinquent
 and unpaid by the Space of fourteen Days next after any or either of the said Heasts or Days of payment whereon the same ought to be paid as aforesaid being lawfully demand and
 not paid and no sufficient Distress or Distresses in or upon the said Premises or any part thereof can or may be found Or if the said Robert Pykes his executors Administrators or
 Assigns shall Commit or do or suffer to be Committed or done in or upon the said Premises or any part or parcel thereof any voluntary Waste Spoil or Detruction to the Value
 of Ten Shillings and upwards in any one Year during the said term Or if the said Robert Pykes his executors Administrators and Assigns shall refuse to do and perform Suit and Service to all and
 the four Courts meeting and meetings of the said Heofees or the Survivors of them Successors or Assigns which shall during the said term hereby granted be helden and
 kept in the Parish Chamber of Culliton aforesaid Or if the said Robert Pykes shall give or bequeath let set or Assign over the said Premises or any part or parcel thereof to any person or
 persons whatsoever except to the said Anne Bole or the said Joseph Baulk without the direction and Consent of three or more of the said Heofees Successors or Assigns in Writing under their hands and
 Seals for that purpose first had and obtained that then and in such Case and from thenceforward for any or either of the causes aforesaid it shall and may be lawfully to and for the said Heofees or the
 Survivors of them Successors or Assigns into the premises hereby demised with the Appurtenances to keepe and the same to have again repossess and enjoy as in their first and former Estate and
 right and thing herein contained to the contrary thereof in any wise notwithstanding And the said Heofees for themselves and their Assigns do Covenant promise Grant and Agree
 to and with the said Robert Pykes his executors Administrators and Assigns and every of them by these presents that the said Robert Pykes his executors Administrators and Assigns shall lawfully may during the
 term hereby granted by and under the yearly Rent heretofore Covenants and Agreements aforesaid peaceably and quietly have hold use Occupie possess and enjoy all and singular the said
 Messuage or Dwelling House and premises and every part and parcel thereof with the Appurtenances Except before Excepted without any the Lawfull Let Suit Trouble Charge Injunction
 disturbance denial or demand whatsoever of or by them the said Heofees or the Survivors of them Successors or Assigns or of by any other person or persons whatsoever claiming or to claime the
 same or any part or parcel thereof by whom or under whom or any of them. WITNESS whereof the parties above named have to these present Indentures, lawfully set their
