

To all Christian people to whom this present writing shall come Robert Edwards of Coliford late in the County of Devon husbandman Buttonge in
 our Lord God everlastingly whereas Robert Weston, Nicholas Hooper, Jasper Butter, Humfray Peke, John Mandeville, and John Poer sometyme messengers of the said lands of Coliford in the County of
 Devon by his deede indentured bearing date the twentye daye of June in the xxvijth yere of the reigne of our late souveraine Ladie Queen Elizabeth, by hys chaffre and couenant of William Paule Gader
 squire, Richard Hooper, ffrauncis Chastellor John Choburgh, George Estrebridge, Walter Weston, Thomas Sampson, Walter Morris, Simon Piperton, John Coper, John Ham and the rest of the men
 twentye men of his foylaid wifte, for he consideracion hym expressyd, did witness to floure lett and conuenient unto John Gold alio Tamer (son) of Kilington in the County aforesaid Barker, and
 Emelle his wifte Ale hat Bawne by hys chaffre sometyme called by the name of Olden-bawne, one smale pide of ground to ysame adiuyuate contyning by estmaton lxxvi aires of land,
 one olde or fayre called the wryng or fayre contyning by estmaton an aire of land, and one littel plott of ground to ysame adiuyuate called the wryng plott contyning by estmaton one arod
 of land more or less. And also all pathys wayes easements commodities & poyntes whatchuse to his said Bawne or fayre & other his poyntes beloninge or appertayninge Ale his said wifte by hys
 appurtenance art situall bytme and beinge hym in the Borough of Coliford in the said County of Devon and hym in the County of and occupacion of the said John Gold alio Tamer or ge his assygnes or
 assygned **To haue** and to hold the same poyntes to his said John Gold alio Tamer and Emelle his wifte for tyme of thare naturall lides and the lyst of either of hem longyl livinge The
 remayndre herofe fymidableis after the deades or other determinacion of the saide son John Gold alio Tamer & Emelle his wifte unto his amys son John Gold alio Tamer his
 godfathers administratores and assygnes for tyme of fower score and myndene yeres to come followinge. If Agnes Gold alio Tamer daughter of Robert Gold alio Tamer of Coliford
 aforesaid so longe shall happen to live **Yeedinge** tractamys purf and wif and bider certaine condicione and agreements in this said indentured deede contyned The wif deede was
 delyuered according to order of latte. As in and by his said deede & Indorsment hereupper made most att laige it doth and maye appeare, By vertue whereof his said son John Gold al
 Tamer and Emelle his wifte were of the poyntes lawfullie possessed accordynge. And afterwards as his said son John Gold alio Tamer consideringe his said Emelle a little before his
 death did gyve all his said wifte poyntes and his said Remarkeborow after his decessas togidher in the said wifde indentured deede indentured and he by me gyve wryng hym selfe mentioned and
 gyumented Unto his said Agnes then & nowe his wifte of mete his said Robert Edwards for and during all his same tyme of yeres determinable upon his death of her
 his said Agnes my nowe wifte By foyr schafers & his said Robert Edwards and his said Agnes in the night of his said Agnes entred into alle & singuler his besore wryng poyntes and woyd
 and veynt eynt eynt lawfullie possessed accordynge And so therof possessed **Knowe** vno wone tyme & thys said Robert Edwards for & in consideracion of the sume of thare and twentye poundes
 of god and lawfull monye of England to me in hand att and before hys chaffre and delivryng poyntes by Thomas ffraunclym holder of the poyntes of Coliford aforesaid in his said countee of Devon
 Bishffre wylle & bencallis contyned and paid Westoyn & doe arquyte Edissage his said Thomas ffraunclym his godfathers administratores & assygnes for ever by his poyntes **Bawne** granted
 bargaynal set assygned and sett over And by his poyntes doth for me and my said wifte Bawne bargaynal set assygned and sett over unto his said Thomas ffraunclym the his foylaid wifte
 pide of ground, or fayre and plott of ground and other his recited poyntes welke and singuler her appurtenance And alle his estate right title tyme of yeres intelle and demainne whatchuse
 of mete and my said wifte and either of us of me to hymselfe Together also with his said recited deede indentured
To haue hysde and enlove his said Bawne pide of ground
 or fayre and plott of ground and alle other his recited poyntes wth hym appurtenance Unto his said Thomas ffraunclym his godfathers and assygnes for by alle tyme of alle the foylaid tyme of
 fower score and myndene yeres yet to come and endurunge of me in the same mentioned and expressed in this said indentured deede indentured his said Thomas ffraunclym his godfathers and his assygnes from
 henceforth **Yeedinge** payng doing and exforming all such waies suites seruices rewardeis condicione and agreements in this manner & forme as he dixerit & assygned of his said son John Gold
 alias Tamer by his foylaid recited deede indentured art bound to yeld pay deo and exforment for the same poyntes And **And** if his said Robert Edwards for me myne godfathers & administratores
 do take myn & exauant to me wth his said Thomas ffraunclym his godfathers and assygnes by his poyntes That his said Thomas ffraunclym his godfathers & assygnes alwayes from tyme forth
 during his said tyme of yeres yet to come and endurunge mentioned eynt exprestly in this said recited deede indentured shall our mayne gaud Gold and enlove his said Bawne pide of ground or fayre
 and plott of ground and alle other his recited poyntes wth chaffreis in maner and forme aforesaid and according to the intent and true meanyng of these presents **Exonerated** acquited
 & distrangyd or otherwise suffienceth fayed & fayled garnelys by me his said Robert Edwards myn exdixit or administratores of and from alle & al manner of forme bargaynal granted assygnement
 burthenis charges fayles incombrans & remaynes myn bawne had mad or done or to be mad or done by me his said Robert Edwards and Agnes my wifte or either of us or by his said son John Gold
 alio Tamer his godfathers or assygnes or am of hym or by any other person or persons myn nyghteswre **In myntryes** whereto to this present hys said Robert Edwards haue set my fayre and
 bawne **Veren** the laste daie of October in the yeres of the reigne of our most kyng Edward Lord James by the grace of God of England, Francia & Irland Kyng depyd
 of his fayre or that is to saye of England, Francia and Irland the kyng; and of Scotland the kyng and fortynight. Lymogz Dm Chri iiii # # #
